In this final year of primary education, we will encourage your child to engage their minds and develop greater independence in all that they do. Weekly timetable

Attached to the page is a copy of the Year 6 timetable for the week. You will notice that the first session of the day will begin at 9:00am in the form of reading. Following on from this, your child will typically have either have Storytelling or Maths first, then will have the other (due to the Triple Pathway structure). Afternoons will consist of a mixture of science, topic work and P.E. During this time your child may also receive further work shop sessions and/or mentoring meetings in order to help further support their progress in their personal learning journeys.

PE days

Wednesdays and Fridays (However, it is usually a good idea to bring kit in at the beginning of each week and take it home every Friday to be washed).

Library

Our library day is on a Thursday. However, access for your child to change their book is available on a daily basis so please ensure your child has their book each day. Accessing age-appropriate books

across a wide range of genres will be particularly beneficial in light of your child succeeding with the HPS reading challenges and teacher challenges.
