Year 6 Expectations.

"Homework is a partnership between HPS, the children and you as parents/carers. Between us we create and develop lifelong learners who are equipped and ready for wherever their futures may take them."

Reading

Please read with your child for 25 minutes at least 5 times a week.

If they get stuck on a word that can't be sounded out then please just tell them the word so that they can keep enjoying the story.

Ask your child questions about the book that they are reading.

How do you think the main character is feeling?

Summarise what has happened in the story so far.

What do you think will happen next?

How does the story make you feel?

What has been your favourite part/ least favourite part so far? Why?

Spelling

The spellings that your child will bring home have been learnt in class. The homework activities are designed to encourage your child to use the spellings within their writing.

The spelling task is to be completed in the homework book.

Maths

Sumdog is an online maths package that HPS has bought into. It is an excellent way for children to consolidate the maths that they have learnt in school.

The expectation is that your child uses Sumdog 10 minutes 5 x a week
